

- Persons age 15 or older are required to have a state freshwater fishing license. Find a <u>license dealer</u>
- Remember lifejackets (children 12 and under must wear a PFD)! All boating safety regulations apply
- You must sign an Aquatic Invasive Species Watercraft Inspection/Cleaning Attestation if you will be fishing from a boat.
- The Daily limit for trout on Wapato Lake is 5. No minimum size. It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with and follow the <u>WDFW Fishing Regulations</u>
- Any infractions to the laws or regulations will result in disqualification from the derby. Any on-the-water violations will also result in disqualification from the derby. We want everyone to be safe and have fun.
- All trout entries must be caught on Wapato Lake During the derby (6am-12pm)
- All trout weighed will be marked by a hole punch in a fin or cut tail fin
- All derby fish may be inspected at the time of weigh-in by Washington State Biologists and Derby Officials. All fish may be subject to dissection.
- Award presentations will begin at approximately 1pm at the Wapato Lake Boat Launch. Must be present to win.
